	IMPORTANT INFORMATION			
REGISTRATION	To register, please present yourself at the Waconichi Welcoming Office (KM 4 of the North Road (Route 10), as of 5pm - OPENING HOURS : Monday to Sunday, from 7am to 10pm	*Your camping-fishing stay begins at 5pm. Therefore, you cannot fish on the wildlife reserve before that time, unless you purchase a daily Right of Access Pass at the Rupert Welcoming Office.		
ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE	Arrival on site : 5pm Departure: before 12pm (noon)			
DETAILS ON CABIN ACCOMODATIONS' PACKAGE	Includes camping, Right of Access Pass, and 2 boats/cabin.			
Watercrafts	Personal watercrafts are authorized without motor stroke limits.			
Boat Launching Area	The boat launching area is accessible via Route 167 (km 255), and not from the cabins' access road. We suggest that you bring an auxiliary motor in case the main motor fails.			
Motor Rental	Motor rentals are available on-site (20 hp and less than 10 hp). We recommend that you make a reservation for your 20 hp motor(s) in advance.			
Visitors	Visitors are granted access until 8pm and must leave the site before 10pm.			
Capacity of Cabins	The maximum capacity of the cabins is 4 people (4 ADULTS MAX). To foster interest in youngsters for fishing, children under the age of 18 may be admitted in addition to the capacity.	* Note that cabins are equipped to accommodate 4 people. Please provide the necessary equipment for the comfort of children admitted in addition to the capacity of the cabin.		
Bedding	Bedding is not provided; you must bring sheets, blankets (or sleeping bag), towels, dish to	wels, and table cloths.		
Non-potable water!	It is recommended to bring clean water or to boil water available on site for 10 to 20 minutes.			
Protection of our Resource	To help us preserve our water bodies, make sure your boating equipment is free of invasive aquatic species.			
USE OF EQUIPMENTS PROVIDED	* We remind you that you must use with care and diligence the accessories or equipment that are available to you during your stay. If you notice that any equipment or accessory is missing or defective, please stop using it and report it promptly to an officer at the facility. Any damage or injury resulting from the use of damaged or inadequate equipment or accessories is the sole responsibility of the user.			
FISHING	Most of the lakes situated in this fishing area have lower catch limits than the limits provided for under provincial regulations.			
Lake Waconichi - Lake Trout	Lake trout fishing on Lake Waconichi is garantied until August 7, date after which the quota might be met, forcing the closing of the lake. The daily catch limit is of 2 lake trouts/fisherman. However, the possession limit is of 3/fisherman.			
Wallaye Lakes - No possibilities of fishing on these lakes on the day of arrival or departure	f Walleye and Pike Lakes are awarded by random draws taking place on-site and reserved for clients who booked a minimum of 3 nights stay during high capacity season, OR 2 nights stay during low capacity season. Certain modalities apply. People interested by this complementary offer must consider that these lakes cover a distance of up to 150 km from the Lake Waconichi cabins' area (travelling on gravel roads).			
	PREVENTION			
ROAD SAFETY	Since the distance to be traveled on gravel roads is considerable, it is strongly recommend	ed to bring two (2) inflated spare tires.		
NAUTICAL SAFETY, BOATS AND MOTORS	According to the federal regulations in force, <u>it is forbidden to use a boat</u> unless it carries on board, and in good condition, the following equipment: - Personnal flotation devices in sufficient quantity - A buoyant heaving line of at least 15 m - A waterproof flashlight or 3 pyrotechnic signals if the boat is motorized - Whistle or sound signaling device - A bailer or hand pump - A manual propulsion device

ANIMALS ON THE SITE				
PETS	Dogs are forbiden on all cabin accomodation sites. Anyone who breaches these rules may be required to leave the territory or be given an infraction notice, if applicable. Other pets are prohibited at all times.			
GUIDE DOGS AND ASSISTANCE	Guide dogs and service dogs are allowed without restriction in all buildings and other places. However, they must be easily identifiable by wearing the scarf or harness of the MIRA Foundation or of another recognized association, and be kept on a leash at all times. The code of ethics of the Foundation or of another recognized association must be respected by the people in charge of the dog, more specifically by keeping with them the letter of accreditation of the organization.
