Packages including prospector tent accommodations are free for children under 18 years old	* An exception may be allowed for children IF the group respects the fact that the total possession limit, per species, <u>must never exceed</u> the capacity of the tent (max. 6 quotas) and the max. of 8 people.

MODIFICATION OR CANCELLATION OF YOUR RESERVATION

Conditions required to make a modification:	Same kind of accomodation (cabin or prospector tent) Same activity season Same holder
More than 6 months before the beginning of the stay :	
Cancellation	The client will receive full refund of any amount already paid.
Modification	For modifications of a reservation of equal or lower value than the initial file, the first modification is free of charge. Modification fees in the amount of \$40 are required for all other modification(s) (as of the second one). For modifications of a reservation of a higher value than the initial file, no fees are charged.
Within 1 to 6 months before the beginning of the stay :	
Cancellation	The client will receive full refund of any amount already paid, minus cancellation fees of 30%.
Modification	A modification fee of \$40 applies to all modifications reducing the total cost of the stay. The client will get a refund of the difference, minus the fees (\$40) - when applicable. For modifications of a reservation of a higher value than the initial file, no fees are charged.
Less than 30 days before the beginning of the stay :	
Cancellation	No refund OR postponement of the stay to the following year will be granted.
Modification	A minimum modification fee of \$40 OR 50% of the price difference applies (highest amount is charged) to all modifications reducing the total cost of the stay. The client will get a refund of the difference, minus the fees (\$40 or 50%) - when applicable. For modifications of a reservation of a higher value than the initial file, no fees are charged.

*** Availability of Services** : Please note that if the management restricts or prohibits access to a water body, a trail, a path, or cancels an activity for reasons beyond its control, no modification or cancellation will be accepted and no refund will be granted.

**** Special Weather Conditions** : Please note that if lakes are not thawed before the beginning of the season, or if bad weather prevents preparation of the sites before the opening, no changes or cancellations will be accepted and no refund will be granted. Thank you for your understanding!

Capacity of Camps	The maximum capacity of the camps is 6 people. To foster interest in youngsters for fishing, children under the age of 18 may be admitted in addition to the capacity. *** MAXIMUM RATIO OF 3 CHILDREN FOR 1 ADULT MUST BE RESPECTED AT ALL TIMES!	<i>* Note that the camps are equipped to accommodate 6 people. Please provide the necessary equipment for the comfort of children admitted in addition to the capacity of the tent.</i>

Interior Equipment Provided	Camp (12' x 20') equipped with: 2 wooden bunkbeds (double mattress on the bottom one and simple mattress on top), 1 table with 6 chairs, electric refrigerator (4 cu.ft.), 1 electric light, Coleman propane stove (propane not included), camping tableware (8 seats), frying pans, coffee maker, utensils, cupboard, broom, dustpan and 1 wood stove (firewood not included). Make sure to bring lighting for mosquito net shelters.

Bedding	Bedding is not provided; you must bring sheets, blankets (or sleeping bag), towels, dish towels, and table cloths.

Exterior Equipment Provided	Mosquito net shelter, picnic table, BBQ with propane tank (included), electricity and shared water point (Non-potable water). Cold-room (1 unit) and freezing space (1 unit) included in the package, as well as the necessary firewood for heating of the tent.

Non-potable water!	It is recommended to bring clean water or to boil water available on site for 10 to 20 minutes.

Protection of our Resource	To help us preserve our water bodies, make sure your boating equipment is free of invasive aquatic species.

ROAD SAFETY	Since the distance to be traveled on gravel roads is considerable, it is strongly recommended to bring two (2) inflated spare tires.

NAUTICAL SAFETY, BOATS AND MOTORS	According to the federal regulations in force, <u>it is forbidden to use a boat</u> unless it carries on board, and in good condition, the following equipment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Personal flotation devices in sufficient quantity - A buoyant heaving line of at least 15 m - A waterproof flashlight or 3 pyrotechnic signals if the boat is motorized - Whistle or sound signaling device - A bailer or hand pump - A manual propulsion device

** Manual propulsion devices are provided for boats at your disposal. You must provide the required equipment, which can be rented or purchased on-site. Federal Regulations prohibits anyone from operating a motorboat unless proving having passed a Boating Safety Course in Canada before April 1st, 1999, or possessing the Pleasure Craft Operator Card issued by Transport Canada following the successful completion of an Approved Boating Safety Course. If you do not have such proof of competence and would like to rent a motorized boat, you will need to complete a security checklist when renting. For more information, visit the Office of Boating Safety website or contact the Office of Boating Safety at 1-800-267-6687. A load limit is indicated in the boats made available to you and this maximum safety limit must be respected at all times.*

ANIMALS ON THE SITE

PETS	Dogs are forbidden on all prospector tent accommodation sites. Anyone who breaches these rules may be required to leave the territory or be given an infraction notice, if applicable. Other pets are prohibited at all times.

GUIDE DOGS AND ASSISTANCE	Guide dogs and service dogs are allowed without restriction in all buildings and other places. However, they must be easily identifiable by wearing the scarf or harness of the MIRA Foundation or of another recognized association, and be kept on a leash at all times. The code of ethics of the Foundation or of another recognized association must be respected by the people in charge of the dog, more specifically by keeping with them the letter of accreditation of the organization.
